Brian and Fiona Hanifan - the power of giving

Our story: Over the years I, (Brian) have been challenged in my attitude to giving back to God. One of the most powerful experiences I have had in that area is related to our pharmacy business.

In 2010 we opened a new pharmacy from scratch. Such a venture involves borrowing a huge amount of finance, to the extent that everything we owned was tied to the business. Things did not go as planned, and by early 2012 we were facing the very real prospect of bankruptcy, in fact we came within 24 hours of losing everything (materially). In the months leading up to that fateful day, despite earning no income, I really felt God challenge me to tithe as though I was earning a full salary. With Fiona's support that was what we did.

This was an extremely difficult time financially, but we learned to simply trust God, whatever the outcome may be. I vividly remember the final creditor's meeting, and being at complete peace.

We were given a reprieve of 6 months by our creditors. The VERY next day, the pharmacy sales jumped by 50%, and just kept on growing and growing. There has been no logical explanation for this, apart from the hand of God. Praise him!!

Believe me, we now give with joy, knowing that He is faithful.

Carol Sharpe - revival has been here before

1970: Carol was a uni student at the time returning to Devonport in August/September for vacation. She came back to her parents and older sister radically changed, "they had a joy and freedom they hadn't had before." Carol went along to a prayer meeting at the church (Methodist Church at the time) and experienced people speaking in tongues for the first time, she thought it was weird, but she knew they had a relationship with God she didn't have. Carol was part of the revival back then, and at a youth camp she encountered Jesus for the first time and gave her life to Jesus. She recalls many being saved, including those with rough backgrounds and on drugs, set free and serving Jesus. "I went back to uni a different person."

What has happened in the last 12 months?



Windows in the hall have been upgraded

The Next 12 months:

New Kitchen

Finances have been secured for the renovation and upgrade of our kitchen. We hope to begin work within the next 12 months, with the hope to create an up-to-date, fully functional kitchen that will serve its purposes well.

Fence

The wall that had previously been leaning over has been brought upright ready for work to commence and the installation of the new fence starting soon, with finances also secured for this work. Another significant project to ensure safety of kids on our premises.

Why a building?

We believe God has given us this building as a gift, a meeting place, a **certain place**, somewhere where we can gather together as the Church.

Our heart over the past years has been to take ground in the city of Devonport for these purposes, to see **His Kingdom Come**.

In ensuring we are good stewards and wise investors of this place we wanted to have a permanent home, so other giving can eventually be sown into other areas.

As mentioned in testimonies shared, a revival was once in this place. We have been given more than we can imagine when it comes to taking ground in Devonport and we are believing we will see revival again, in every heart, for every generation.

Giving to the future:

Archer Street car park resurfacing

The surface of the rear car park is not in good condition with the weather often deteriorating the surface. The plan is to re-bitumen this area to make it safer for our elderly and families.

Equal Sacrifice, not Equal Giving.

Our hope for Vision Builders is that everyone would choose to partner with us in giving freely and generously. Your decision should be based on both **faith** and **wisdom**. The philosophy of Vision Builders is <u>equal sacrifice</u>, not <u>equal</u> giving.

Once you have decided on your level of giving, make a formal commitment to give whatever sum of money you feel God is asking you to give through either;

- Regular contributions toward your commitment by weekly, fortnightly, or monthly giving.
- A one-off gift from funds you currently have available.
- · Giving from proceeds of a sale of goods, services or an asset.

History shows a "First Fruits" offering (initial deposit), then regular monthly giving is the best way of fulfilling commitments. For the sake of convenience you may wish to set up a direct transfer into the supplied bank details, or you can give at our Sunday services, using supplied envelopes, into boxes located in the front and rear foyers.

Deciding What to Give.

Here are some examples of regular giving, and what your pledge could look like:

- Plan and write down how you will fulfil your pledge. Keep giving as regularly as possible so your commitment doesn't become a burden.
- 5 PARTNER
 We're in this together. Be encouraged as we pray and believe for lives to be transformed in our community.
